We expect you to browse your Mastodon feed and then reflect on your browsing experience and answer two questions regarding each post. We'll use the data we collect to build a feed curation tool, during which we will experiment with large language models including Claude and GPT.

The reasonably foreseeable risks or discomforts to the subject as a result of participation:

No foreseeable risk. We respect your filters and block lists. No content beyond your home feed will be shown. Data will be de-identified before being sent to any large language model API service in order to protect your privacy.

The benefits to the subject or to others, e.g., society:

The data collected in the study will be used to create a feed curation algorithm that prioritizes what users actually want to see (rather than optimizing for engagement).

The alternative procedures, if any, that might be advantageous to the subject:

Participants can exit the study at any time if they so choose.

Confidentiality:

All records from this study will be kept confidential. Your responses will be de-identified before being input into large language models. We will also not include any information that will make it possible to identify you in any report we might publish.

Research records will be stored securely in a locked cabinet and/or on password-protected computers. The research team will be the only party that will have direct access to your unmasked data.

Compensation:

Participants will be compensated \$5 for completing the entire study.
